The company specializes in the exploration, development, and production of oil, natural gas, and natural gas liquids (NGLs) across several prolific U.S. basins, including the Delaware Basin, Eagle Ford, and the Rockies. As of 2024, Devon reported a production rate of approximately 737,000 barrels of oil equivalent per day and held proved reserves of 1.817 billion BOE.
