4. Revenue

For the fiscal year ending December 31, 2024, Northern Trust reported annual revenue of \$15.876 billion, marking a 31.02% increase from 2023. For the twelve months ending March 31, 2025, revenue totaled \$15.824 billion, reflecting a 21.61% year-over-year growth.

5. Institutions with Buy Recommendations:

As of the latest reports, the consensus among analysts is a "Hold" rating for Northern Trust's stock, with an average target price of \$102.18. Price targets range from a low of \$81 to a high of \$128, indicating varied expectations about the company's future performance.

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6. Analyst Sentiment Summary
