Truist Financial Corporation is a purpose-driven financial services company formed by the 2019 merger of BB&T and SunTrust Banks. Headquartered in Charlotte, North Carolina, Truist offers a wide array of services, including retail and commercial banking, asset and wealth management, mortgage services, payments, and capital markets. As of March 31, 2025, the company reported total assets of \$536 billion, ranking it among the top 10 commercial banks in the U.S.

1. Top 5 Competitors

Truist competes with several major financial institutions. Its top five competitors include:

4. Revenue

For the fiscal year ending December 31, 2024, Truist reported annual revenue of \$24.25 billion, marking a 19.02% decline from the previous year.

5. Institutions with Buy Recommendations:

As of June 2025, Truist Financial Corporation has received buy recommendations from several financial institutions and analysts. The company has been rated as a "Buy" by multiple analysts, reflecting positive sentiment towards its stock.

6. Analyst Sentiment Summary

Analyst sentiment towards Truist Financial Corporation is generally positive. The stock has received a consensus rating of "Buy" from analysts, with an average price target of \$48.27, suggesting potential upside from current levels.
